

## FAQ: 31035 HOW DO I GET RID OF OLD CALL LOGS?

### PURGING OLD LOGS

If you never purge old call logs off your Call Accounting System, eventually your system will fill up and you will get an error 56 to indicate that your hard drive is full. You can use the oldlogs utility to keep your drive space free, or you can manually go into your system and delete old call logs.

### DOWNLOADING THE OLDLOGS.EXE UTILITY

### SYNTAX FOR RUNNING OLDLOGS.EXE UTILITY

The syntax for running the oldlogs.exe utility is:  
OLDLOGS.EXE [# DAYS TO KEEP] [FILE EXTENSION – DEFAULT is \*.LOG]

### EXAMPLE OF OLDLOGS.EXE COMMAND LINES

OLDLOGS.EXE 30	Keep 30 days of logfiles (*.log) on file, delete the rest
OLDLOGS.EXE 30 *.LOG	Same as the command above
OLDLOGS.EXE 180	Keep 6 months of logfiles on file, delete the rest
OLDLOGS.EXE 360	Keep 1 years log files on file, delete the rest
OLDLOGS.EXE 90 *.CSV	Delete .CSV Files Older then 90 days

### AUTOMATING THE OLDLOGS.EXE UTILITY IN WINDOWS SCHEDULED TASKS

The utility deletes logs from the directory where the OLDLOGS.EXE utility is located. If you want to automate this routine you should use a batch file and put the batch file in the Windows Schedule. A sample batch file is as follow:

```
C:
CD\CA2005\LOGFILES
OLDLOGS 360
```
