ANSWER

The basic commands for polling a memory buffer manually are as follows:

| 1. Reset Partition: | ^B00 | PRT |
| 2. Send # of Records: | ^B20 | RC |
| 3. Release Records | ^B01 | RL |
| 4. Erase Records | ^B25 | CLEAR |
| 5. Buffer Setup | ^B16 | SETUP |
| 6. Hang up Modem | ^B09 | HANGUP |
